

### What do I have to pay now?

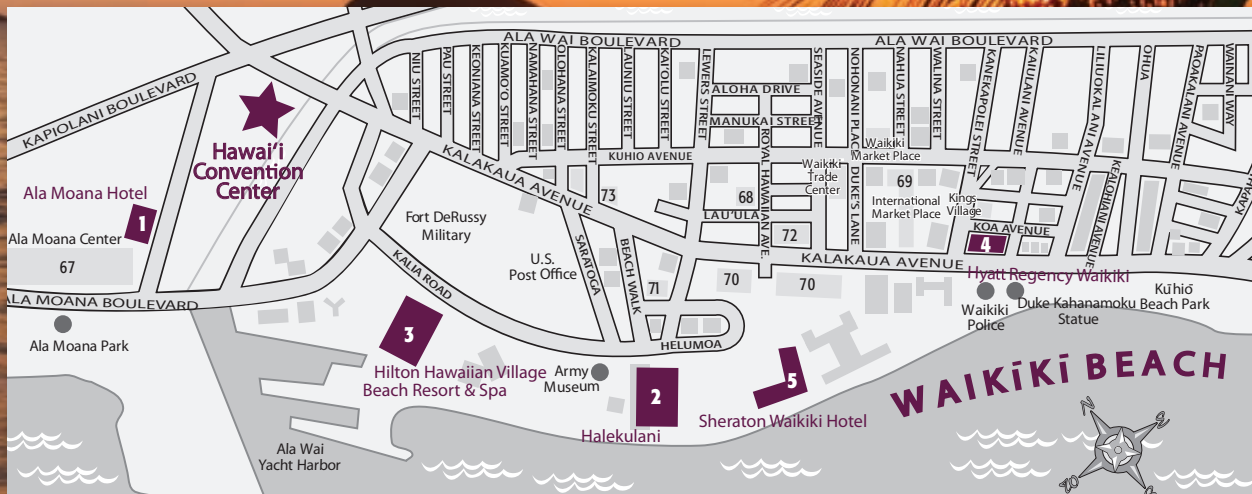
In order to secure housing, attendees must register for the meeting.

## OFFICIAL AAP ANNUAL MEETING HOTELS

The AAP has appointed Experient as the official registration and housing coordinator for the 2010 Annual Meeting. All housing is reserved through Experient for the AAP room block, and hotels cannot accept reservations made directly. A portion of the room rate is being paid to Experient as a provider of the Academy's housing service. You must register for the meeting to secure housing. A \$200 deposit, payable by check or credit card, is required to reserve housing. Hotel room rates are subject to the current Hawaii tax of 13.96%.

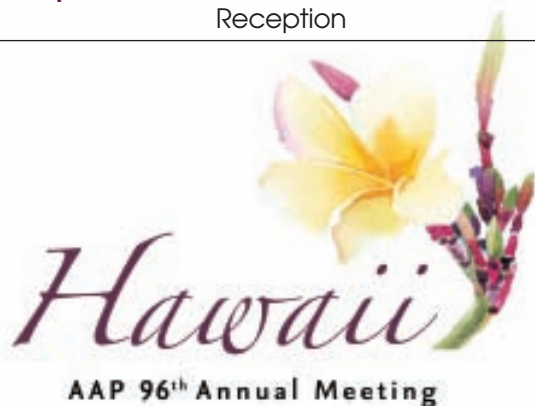
