

HOW TO REGISTER

Complete the enclosed Housing and Registration Form (pages 67-68) and do one of the following:

Please use only one method of transmission to avoid duplicate records and multiple charges. Housing reservations and meeting registration cannot be accepted over the phone. Make checks payable to The American Academy of Periodontology, or charge your fees with Visa or MasterCard. Other credit cards, Euro Cards, purchase orders and wire transfers are not accepted. The deadline for housing reservations is August 1, 2008. Online registration will remain open from August 2-September 5, 2008, but registrants will be charged the on-site registration fee.

MEMBERSHIP NUMBER

It is imperative that members of the Academy place their membership number on the Housing and Registration Form. Failure to do so could result in a delay of processing.

PROFESSIONAL REGISTRANTS

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES may a dentist register as a guest, spouse, exhibitor, dental assistant, dental hygienist, office staff, family member or dental trade. Registration will be revoked for dentists who register in any category other than dentist, and the dentist will be charged the appropriate registration fee or will be asked to leave the meeting. Spouses who are dentists are considered dentists, and therefore, are expected to register as dentists. This is particularly true if you are seeking CE credits from the AAP.

SPOUSE REGISTRATION

An approved AAP member category is allowed one (1) spouse/guest registration. Approved registration categories are Active, Associate, International and Honorary members. Persons that register in the Spouse/Guest category are entitled to attend the following courses and events.

AAP Foundation Booth

AAP/AAPF Corporate Forum

Exhibition

Opening Ceremony and Reception

Research Forum Poster Session

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will spouses be allowed to attend any continuing education courses, including General Sessions, Innovations in Periodontics, Focused CE and Hands-On Workshops.

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

All attendees will be required to show a valid form of identification (state-issued driver's license or government-issued passport) in order to pick-up their registration credentials, register for the meeting, pick-up additional tickets or utilize any Scan & Go station. Attendees may only pick-up their own registration credentials.

OTHER IMPORTANT REGISTRATION POLICIES

General registration for the meeting is required to register for ticketed events and programs (with the exception of the AAP/AAP Foundation Presidents' Gala, the Dental Hygiene Symposium and the Insurance Workshops).

Members in the Active, Associate, International and Honorary member categories may purchase a maximum of four tickets for each Insurance Workshop for distribution to staff. Staff will not be required to register for the meeting, nor will they receive a badge, and are not considered registered for the meeting, nor will they be allowed to attend other meeting functions or have access to any areas of the Exhibit Hall, including the AAP Center and AAP Foundation areas.

REGISTRATION

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Due to the large number of attendees often registering online at the exact same time, occasionally access is granted to a program on the initial acknowledgement that it is already sold out. Please do not consider your event ticket confirmed until you receive a formal confirmation from Experient.

EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION

In accordance with the Academy's Crisis Management Plan, we are asking attendees to provide emergency contact information in the event an emergency arises during the Annual Meeting. This information will be maintained by Academy staff and will not be used for purposes other than in the event of an emergency.

SCAN & GO

New this year! The AAP will utilize Scan & Go stations to expedite the registration process. "Scan" and "Go" describes self-registration where pre-registrants can swipe their confirmation barcode (received prior to the meeting) and print off their badge and tickets on-site. All attendees must present a valid state- or government issued photo ID. Attendees may use their name and e-mail address in lieu of the confirmation barcode. No badge reprints will be available on-site.

Who is eligible:

- International registrants (outside the US and Canada) who registered between May 1-September 5, 2008
- Late registrants (inside the US and Canada) who registered between August 2-September 5, 2008

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

Registration forms must be received by August 1, 2008 for early pricing. Late Registration (on-site pricing) will be open from August 2-September 5, 2008, 12:00 noon Central Time. Additionally, late registration is only available online; no registrations will be processed via fax or mail beginning August 2, 2008. Confirmations will be e-mailed if an e-mail address is provided. Allow 72 hours for receipt of your registration confirmation. Contact Experient at 866-229-2386 or 301-694-5243 if you do not receive your confirmation within 72 hours, as this delay could be the result of your housing request being unavailable.

NAME BADGES AND TICKETS

Early Registration:

Attendees in the United States and Canada who register by August 1, 2008 will receive their badges and all event tickets prior to arriving at the meeting. Badges and tickets will be mailed first-class beginning July 28, 2008. No badges or tickets will be mailed after August 15, 2008. Early registrants in the United States and Canada should pick-up their complimentary registration tote bags and continuing education note pads and pens in the Registration area.

Registration badges and tickets will be held for on-site pick-up by pre-registered international attendees. All international attendees (those outside of the United States and Canada) who register by August 1, 2008 may pick-up their registration materials at any Scan & Go station in the Registration area by swiping the barcode found on the confirmation letter.*

Late Registration:

Attendees who register between August 2-September 5, 2008 must do so online (no mail or faxes accepted) and must print off their badges and tickets on-site in the Scan & Go area.* Online Late Registration closes September 5, 2008 at 12:00 noon Central Time.

On-Site Registration:

On-Site Registration opens September 5, 2008 at 3:00 pm Pacific Time in the South Lobby, Level 4, of the Washington State Convention & Trade Center, and continues through September 9, 2008. No badge reprints will be offered on-site.

** Late registrants or those early registrants without confirmation letters may use their name and e-mail address in lieu of a confirmation page.*

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Refunds will be granted to registrants who submit written refund requests prior to August 15, 2008, less a set administrative fee based on handling costs. Registrants who make refund requests in writing after August 15, 2008 may have refund dollars applied toward Annual Meeting registration and fees for the 2009 Annual Meeting on a one-time “use it or lose it” basis.

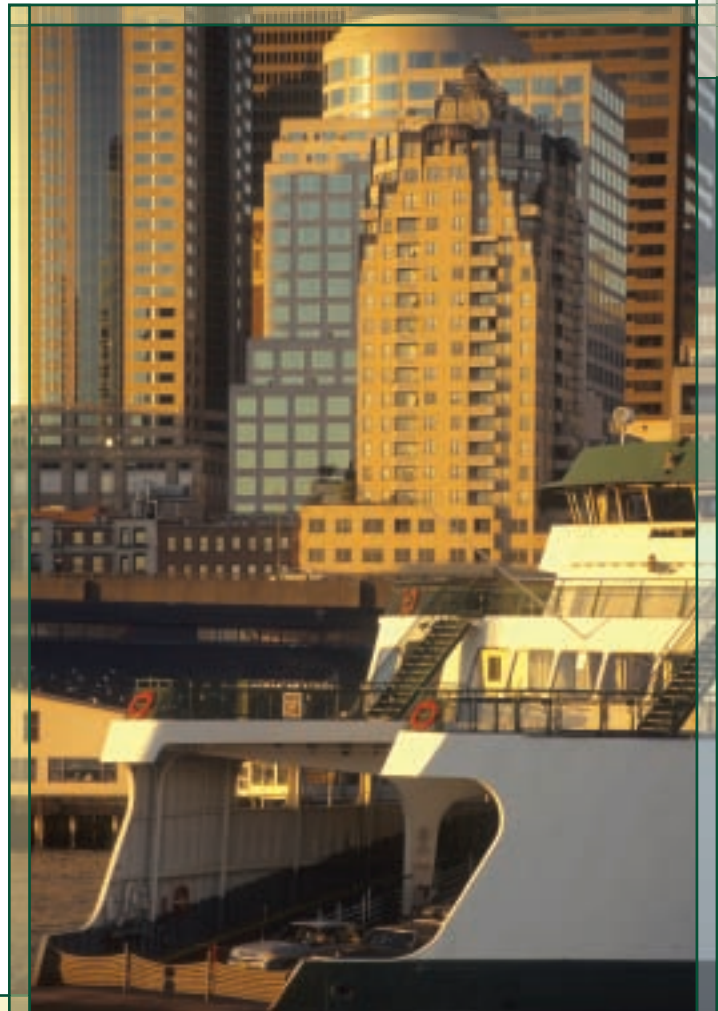
REGISTRATION LOCATION/HOURS
